

Highlights of the programme (Max 100 words): The Seminar was organized jointly by Geology Department, GSS College, Belagavi with its MoU institutions Gogate-Jogalekar College, Ratnagiri; and Mining Engineers' Association of India, Belgaum Chapter, on ZOOM. Wetlands are among the world's most valuable and bio- diverse ecosystems. It is reported that these wetlands are disappearing at an alarming speed, three times faster than forests, owing mainly to anthropogenic influence, especially urbanisation and agriculture shifts. The most vulnerable are the animals and plants. These wetlands are vital source of flood, raw materials and genetic sources for medicines and these also provide a livelihood for the people living around, and also mitigate the floods and protect the coastlines. These wetlands therefore are biodiversity hot spots and need to be protected. Dr.G.N.Nayak, delivered his talk on important aspects of wetlands including definitions, classification, importance of wetlands in climate change research, how the metals are stored in wetland sediments and related pollution, research methods with case study along Maharashtra-Goa Coastal wetlands. Dr Prasad Karnikar, delivered his talk on peoples participation to save the wetlands and the related environments especially Mangroves, their importance in ecology, coastal erosion, biodiversity with case study from Thane creek.
